Very effective at destroying many types of caterpillars (which are leaf eaters in the larvae stage)

Considered to be the most widely beneficial insect, due to it's effectivity on a wide variety of pests.

They fight by laying their eggs inside the eggs of their prey.
The Trichogramma

eggs hatch first, eating the prey's eggs before they hatch! The Tomato Hornworm which infests many gardens, is one of the wasps favorite targets!
