FIELD NOTES:

▶ With no queen to protect, they are very unlikely to sting.

▶ They are active in colder temperatures, effectively pollinating fruit trees in orchards!

▶ Thanks to the many tiny hairs on the Mason Bee's body, they are 120 times more effective than honey bees, which increases plant bloom and yield from fruit trees!

▶ Not susceptible to the Varroa Mite which has caused havoc with honey bees all over North America.
