2.	Mason Bees are 1/3 inch long and are a dark iridescent \square blue \square orange \square yellow with hairy bodies. The male mason bees have a small white "mustache" on their face and are \square bigger \square smaller than the females and have no stinger.
3.	Like the honeybee, Mason Bees are pollinators. In fact, Mason Bees are very beneficial because they are considered hyper pollinators and one mason bee can do the work of \square 2 \square 12 \square 120 honey bees.
4.	Mason Bees can be used at the beginning of \square fall \square spring \square summer when it's too cold for the honey bees to come out.
5.	When laying eggs, the female will start by going to the \square front \square back of the tube laying an egg, depositing some pollen and nectar for food, and building a wall using mud and saliva creating a cell for each egg. The mason bee will produce \square males \square females first placing them in the back of the tube.
6.	The larvae will spend fall and winter in their cocoon and the adults will emerge in early a spring summer.
7.	The Mason Bee Habitat is used to repel attract the mason bees to your customer's garden. It contains the mason bee habitat, tubes, mounting hardware and instructions on how and where to mount the nest.
8.	The Mason Bee Starter Kit supplies your customers with everything they need to get started: mason bee habitat, Blue Orchard Mason Bee Book, 6 live bee cocoons shipped in a paper tube. True False
